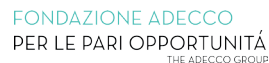

What's on offer?

FOR THE COMPANIES:

1 Focus groups to identify the skills and job profiles needed to facilitate labour market insertion of migrants. **2 Diversity management workshops** to raise awareness of integration and diversity in the workplace. **3 Recognition for the companies** who are active in the integration of migrants and promotion of the initiative **Employers Together for Integration** of the European Commission.

FOR THE MIGRANTS:

1 Skills assessment and identification of training needs. **2 Improvement of language and job skills** according to the needs of the local companies in order to prepare for a placement. **3 Matching and preparing migrants for** placements with the companies **involved in the project.**

FOR THE TUTORS:

1 Training on the use of innovative tools and methodologies for the skills assessment of migrants. **2 Promotion of the use of the EU Skills Profile Tool for Third Country Nationals** of the European Commission.

Our methodology

E.M.M.E. develops an approach based on the activity of local networks composed of key actors in the field of socio-economic inclusion of migrants, vocational training and support for companies.

The approach will be implemented in three local contexts: Italy (Tuscany), United Kingdom (Scotland) and Spain (Andalusia).

At local level the organisations will co-operate to implement the proposed activities.
